The Water Cycle





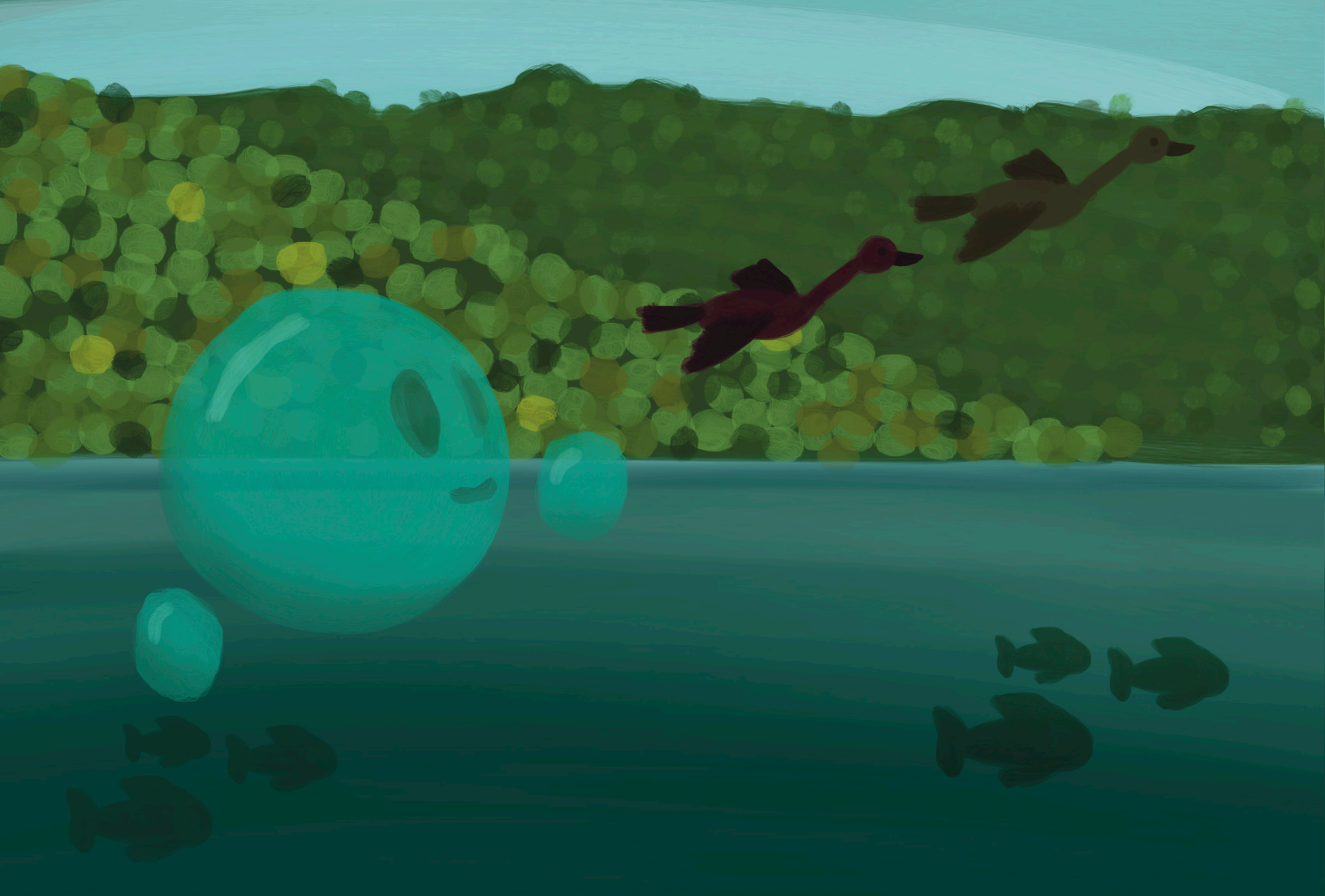
Druple is a water molecule

warm sun!





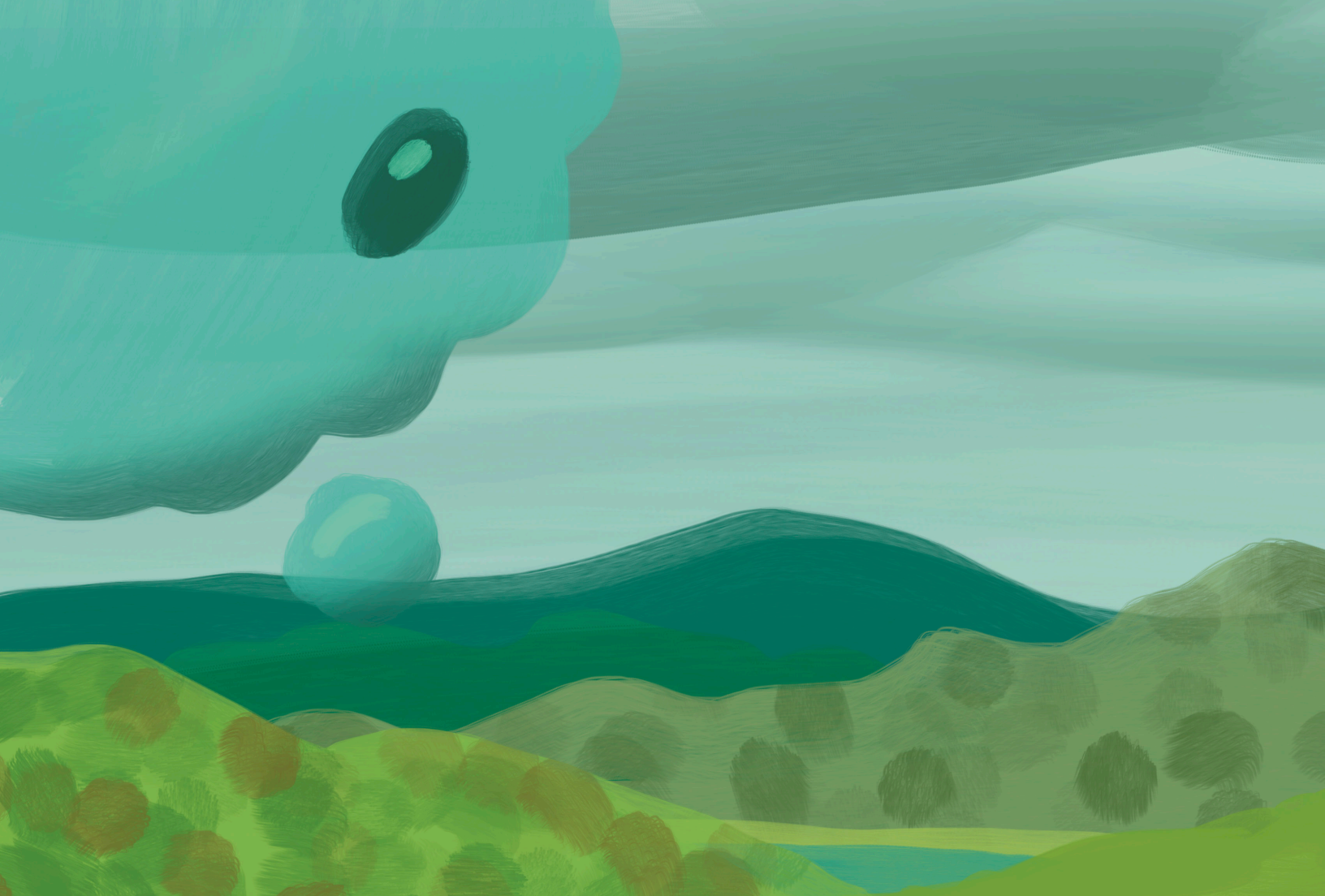
He is so

new friends!

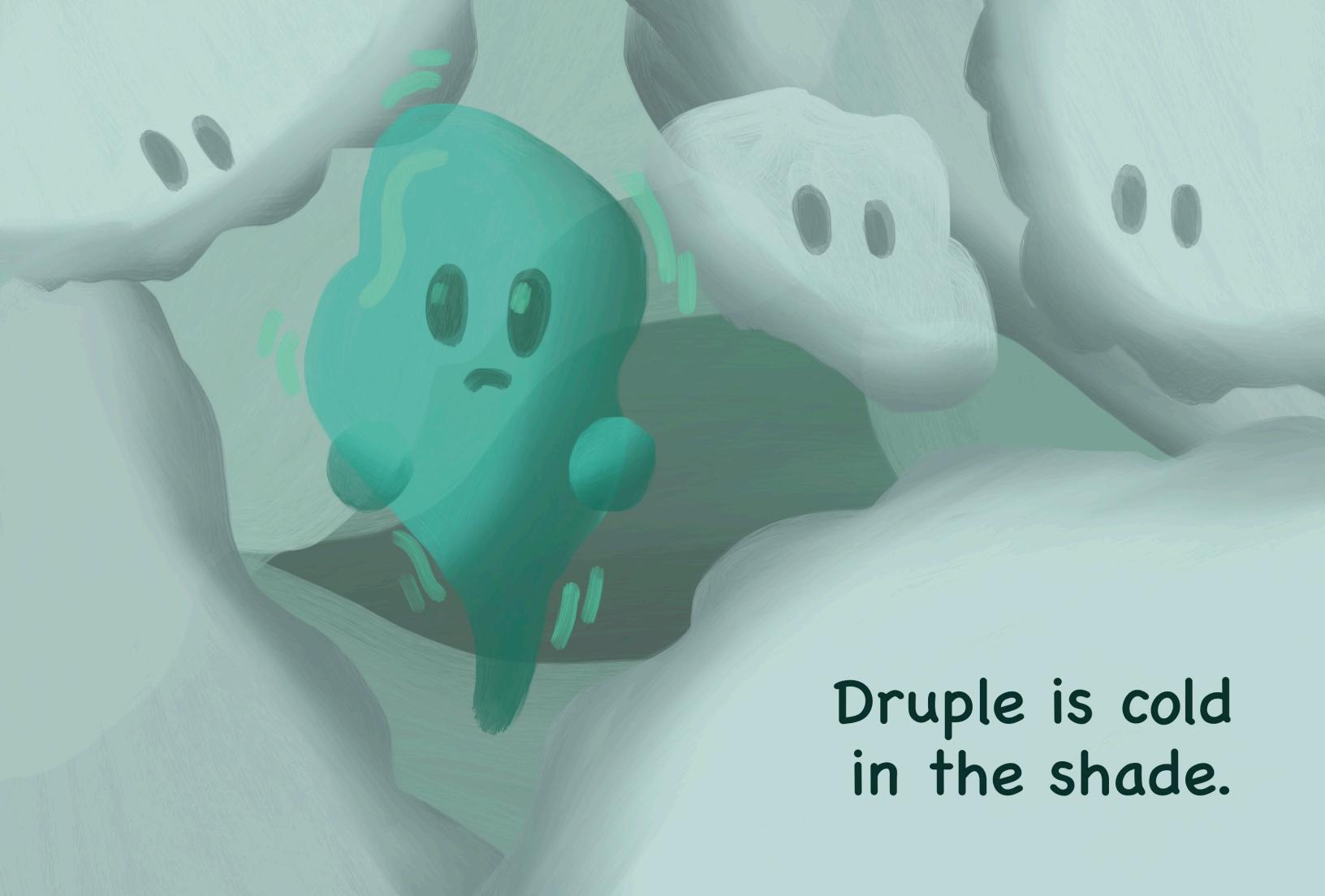


They run and play!

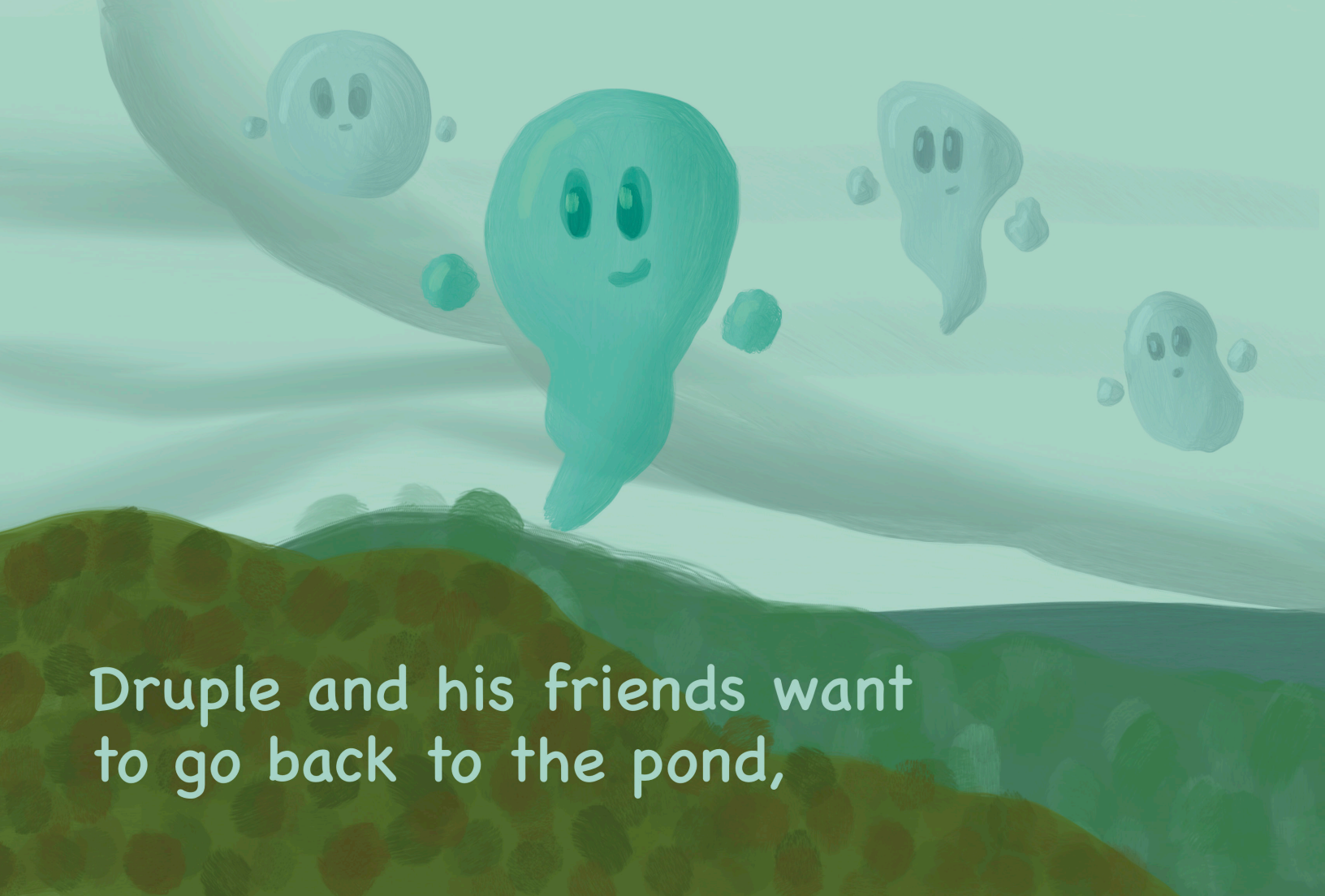




Eventually,  
the cloud gets too crowded.



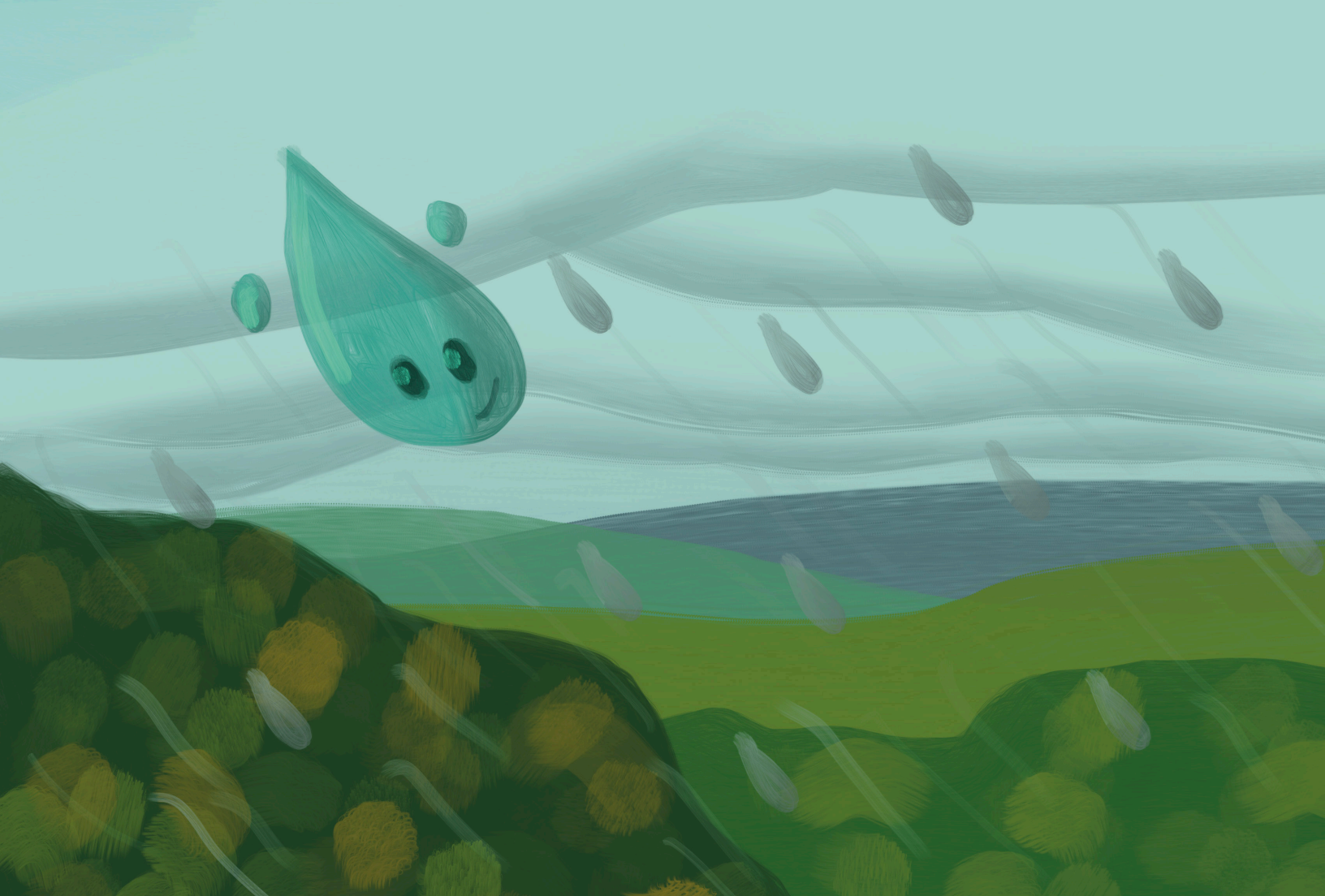
Druple is cold

to go back to the pond,

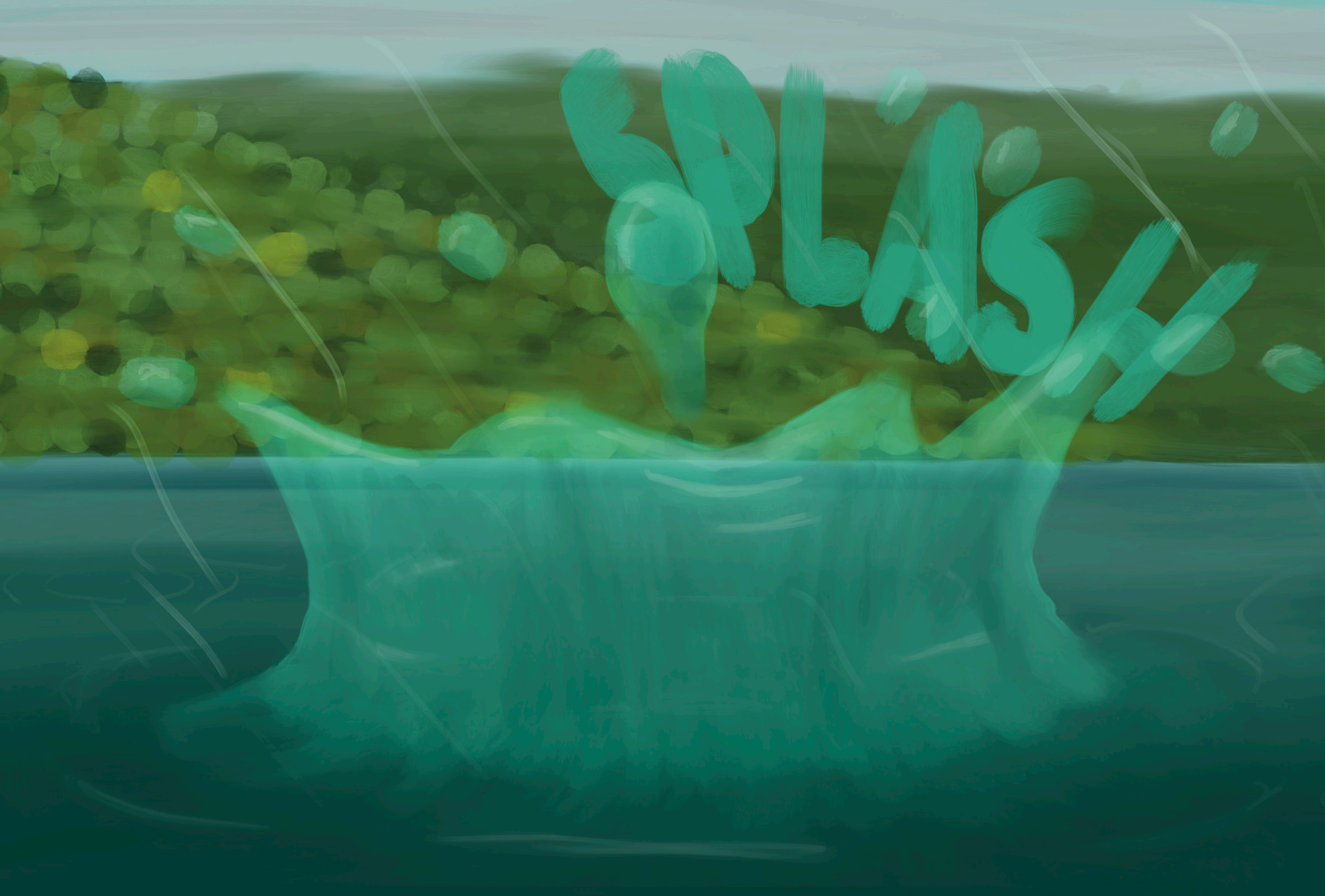

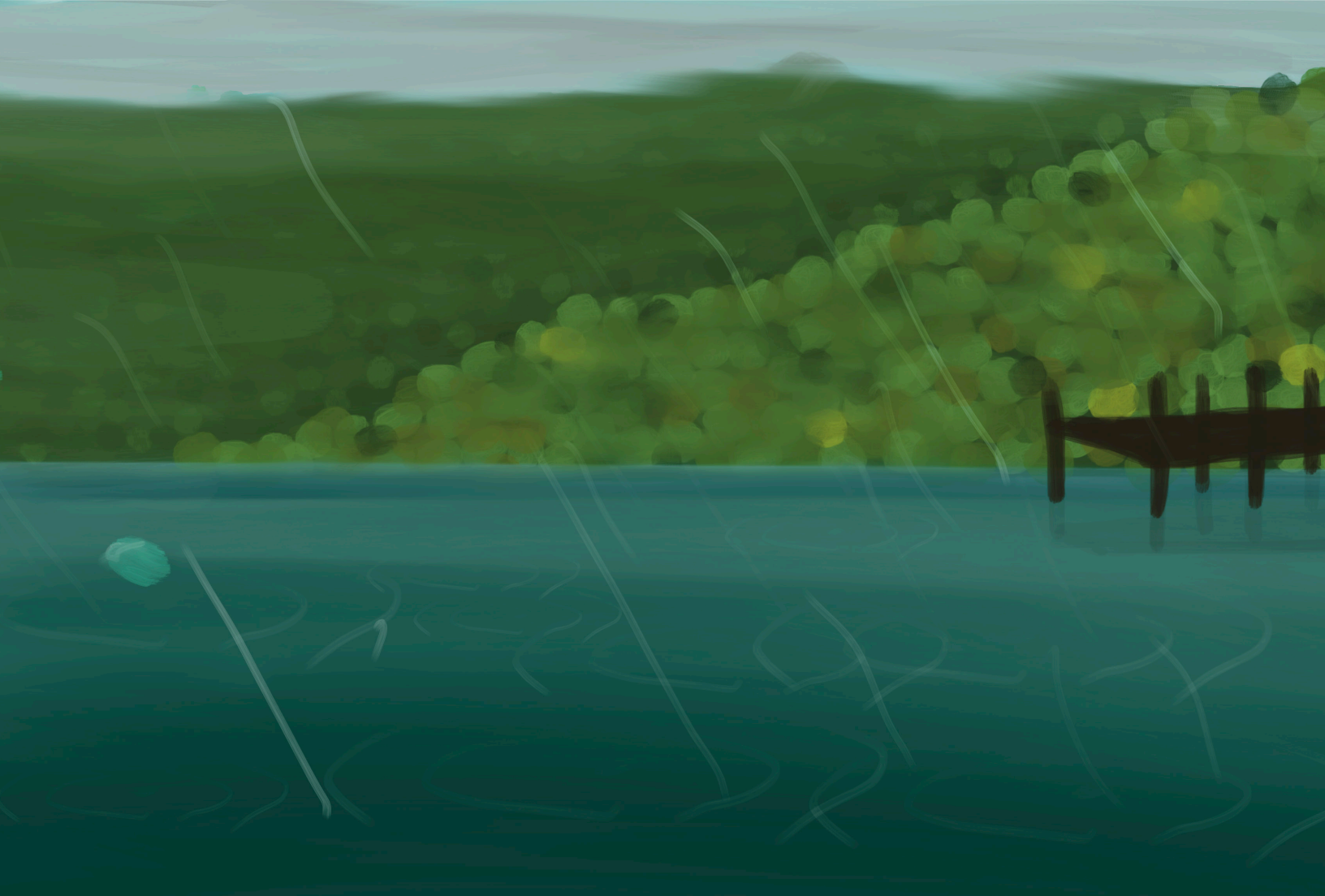
